The Oregon Coalition Against Domestic & Sexual Violence (OCADSV) is proud to announce the launch of **Cycle the WAVE Oregon (Women Against Violence Everywhere)**, a fully supported, non-competitive, all-women's cycling event. This bike event is for cisgender and transgender women and girls of all ages and fitness levels to experience camaraderie, increase public awareness about domestic and sexual violence, and raise funds for survivors of domestic and sexual violence across Oregon.

Proceeds from this event will contribute toward the establishment of **a flexible fund for survivors of abuse across the state**. This fund would provide a much-needed bridge to defray expenses survivors may incur while escaping abuse.
