

The Oregon Coalition Against Domestic and Sexual Violence Prevention Through Liberation project Summer 2018 Capacity Building Mini-Grants Applications due by Friday, May 25th, 2018

Project Description:

The Oregon Coalition Against Domestic and Sexual Violence has launched the Prevention Through Liberation grant project. This project will award four (4) capacity building mini-grants at \$5,000.00 each, to increase organizational capacity to increase culturally specific prevention efforts in Oregon antiviolence programs. OCADSV recognizes that oppression is a root cause of sexual violence and that the impacts of systemic oppression place historically marginalized communities at greater risk.

Purpose:

To build organizational capacity to provide culturally specific and relevant prevention projects that identify promising sexual violence prevention models focused on historically marginalized communities:

- Identify and strengthen prevention efforts in historically marginalized communities
- Create prevention strategies that address systematic oppression as a root cause for sexual violence

Example projects may include the following:

- Develop & host community listening sessions
- Mini photovoice project
- Community asset mapping
- Community strengths/needs assessment
- Develop a framework/model of change
- Attend a training or bring in a trainer that increases organizational capacity
- Community and/or organizational leadership development (i.e. attend or enroll in leadership development course, training, etc.)
- Organizational Strategic Plan to address prevention
- Sexual violence prevention organizational training
- Organizational assessment

- Funding timeline: June 1, 2018- August 31st, 2018.
- Awardees will need to attend a Conference Call that will review the goal of the mini-grants, provide primary OCADSV Staff Contact, review funding restrictions and reporting requirements on Friday, June 1st.
