Oregon Student Voice State of Our Schools Report

Taking an initial step to elevate student participation in decision-making processes, OSV listened to high school students across Oregon to attain a better comprehension of their perceptions of our education system. More than 2,200 students shared their experiences in an online survey or during focus group discussions. In this report, written by high school students, we analyze responses around different aspects of schooling. We conclude with recommendations for how Oregon's K-12 education system can better support students.

The goal of the annual OSSCC report is to help Oregon educators, advocates and community leaders identify school safety, risks, and resiliency factors for sexual orientation and gender identity minority (SOGI) youth. The Oregon Safe Schools and Community Coalition (OSSCC) 2017 State of Safe Schools in Oregon report analyzed results from the 2017 Oregon Healthy Teens (OHT) survey in relation to results from the US Center for Disease Control's (CDC) 2015 Youth Risk Behavior Surveillance System (YRBSS) and the GLSEN's 2015 National School Climate Survey. Keeping students safe and healthy means engaging families, school administrators, teachers, the students themselves, and communities to help create a learning environment that promotes students' physical, social, and emotional well-being.
