**SUMMARY**

HAVEN From Domestic and Sexual Violence is accepting applications for a part-time English AND part-time/full-time Bilingual/Spanish Mental Health Counselor, to join the counseling team. If not licensed, but has MSW, MA or CSWA, HAVEN will pay for supervision. The position provides culturally and linguistically appropriate counseling services to children and non-offending parents and family members that are survivors of domestic violence, sexual violence, teen dating violence, and stalking, especially those who speak Spanish as their primary language.

Grounded in social justice and the movement to end violence against women, HAVEN is a social service agency serving survivors of domestic violence, sexual violence, teen dating violence, stalking, and human trafficking. Located in The Dalles along the scenic Columbia River, HAVEN from Domestic & Sexual Violence prioritizes work/life balance for its employees, emphasizing self-care and trauma-informed modes of practice for staff, contractors and the survivors HAVEN serves. While the organization began in 1981 in the form of a 24 hour crisis-line and network of volunteers to support victims, HAVEN is now a distinguished anti-violence agency with innovative programming to serve survivors of violence from a social-ecological framework that addresses all aspects of survivors' lives and works to support survivors in their healing journeys.

**COUNSELING SERVICES OVERVIEW:**

Over the past couple years, HAVEN's counseling program has developed a program in which survivors of violence and abuse can receive individual and group counseling, family therapy, parenting training and education as well as parent-child sessions to help individuals develop healthy relationships with their children and teens. Our program has expanded to include creative therapy modalities such as play and art therapy in addition to yoga and mindfulness based-practices all in Spanish and English.
